The Dust Digger

Assembling Your Dust Digger

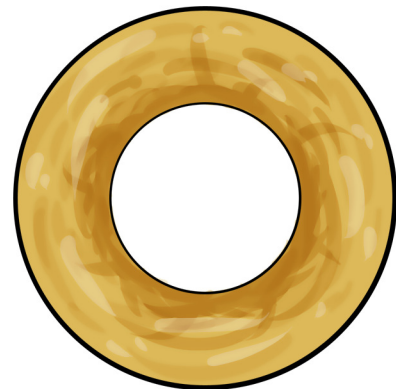
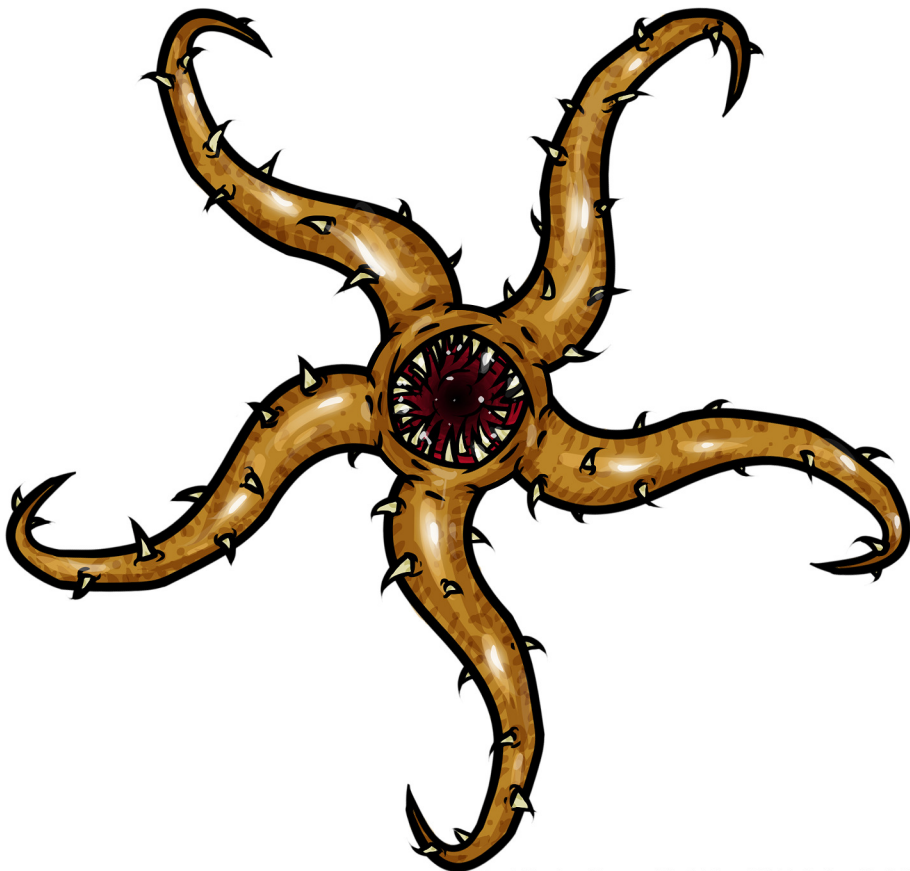
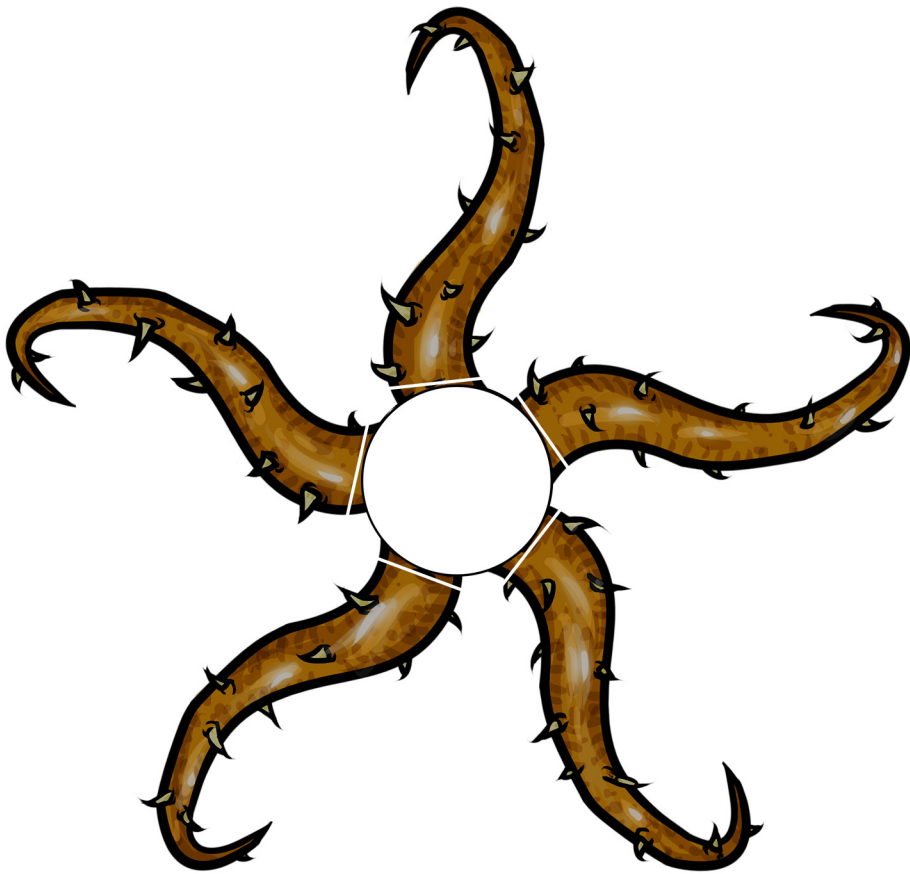
First, follow the instructions found in the free Pathfinder Paper Miniatures instruction PDF, which can be found on Paizo.com.

Once the top section is cut and glued, score each of the white lines on the bottom of the tentacles. Fold all five tentacles up, so each one meets above the dust digger's mouth.

Dab some glue onto the circular base's central circle, then join with the dust digger body's bottom circle. Hold together until glue sets, as per your glue's instructions.

Once the glue has set, fold, bend, and curl the tentacles into whatever position you desire.

Congratulations! You have a sinister dust digger to harry your players!



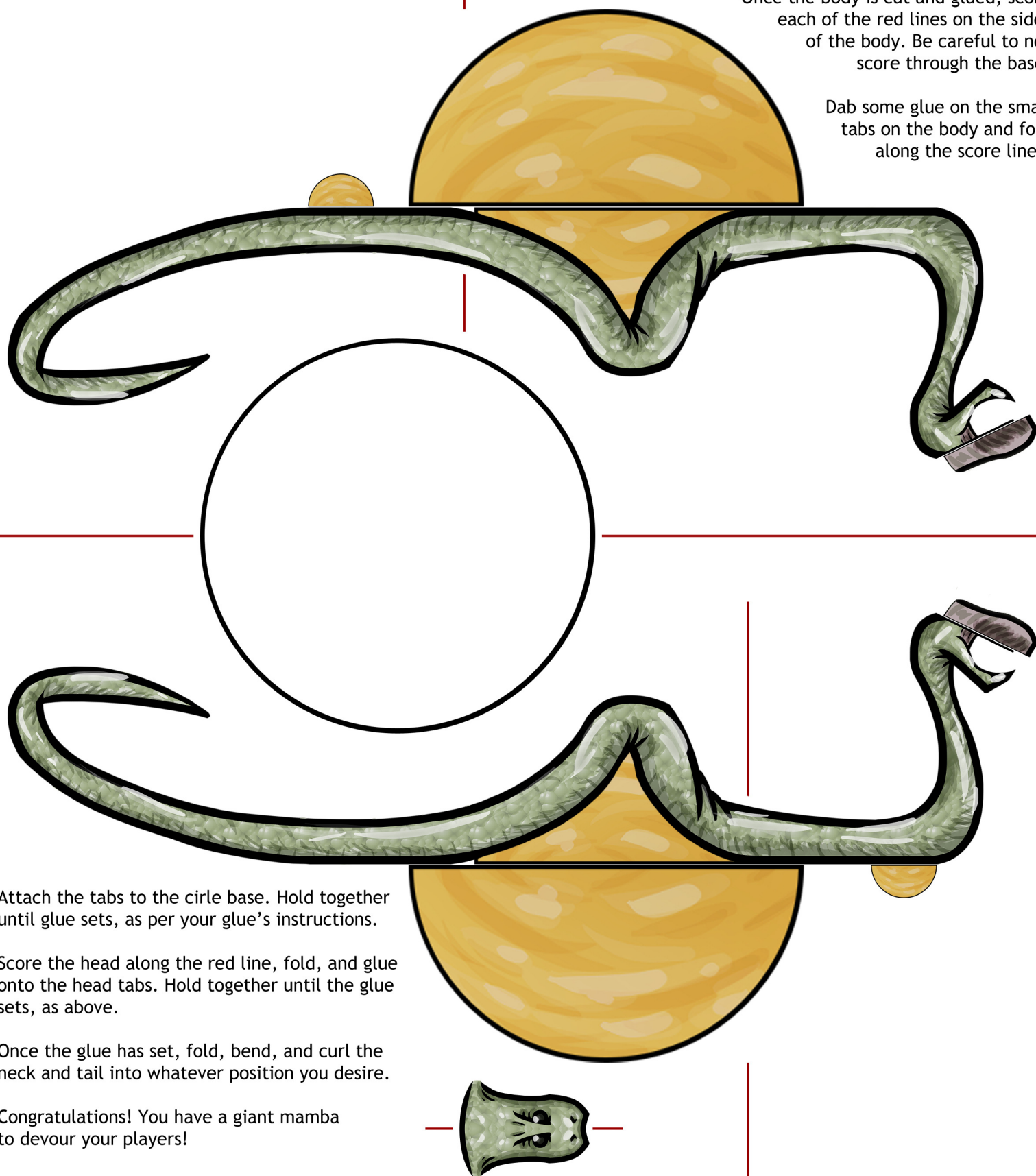
The Giant Mambā

Assembling Your Giant Mamba

First, follow the instructions found in the free Pathfinder Paper Miniatures instruction PDF, which can be found on Paizo.com.

Once the body is cut and glued, score each of the red lines on the sides of the body. Be careful to not score through the base.

Dab some glue on the small tabs on the body and fold along the score lines.



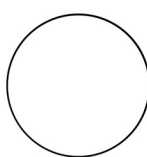
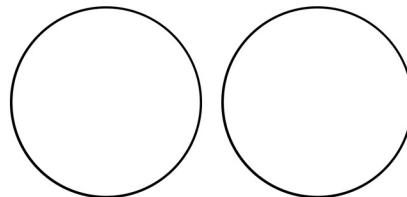
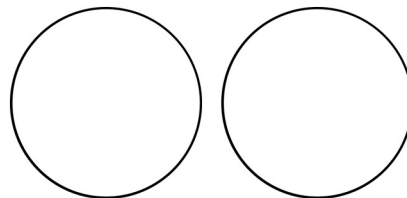
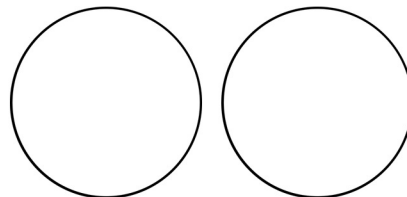
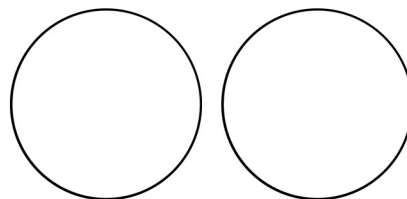
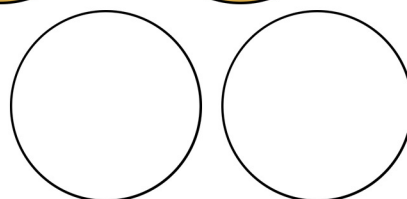
Attach the tabs to the circle base. Hold together until glue sets, as per your glue's instructions.

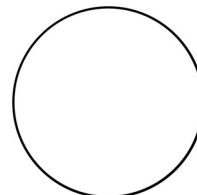
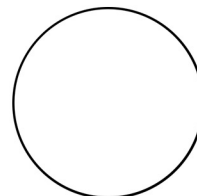
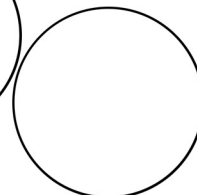
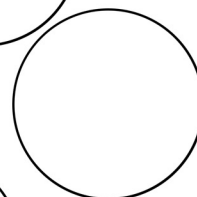
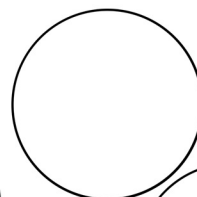
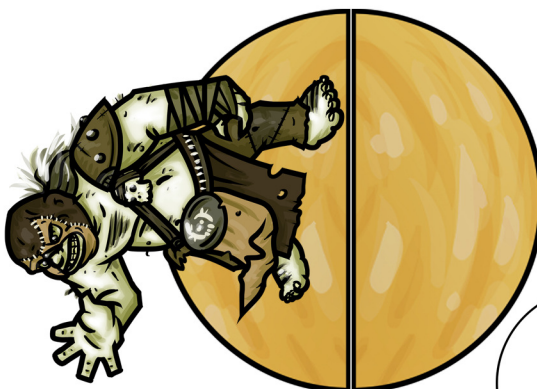
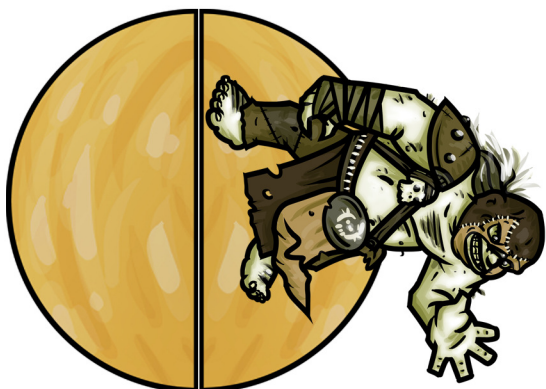
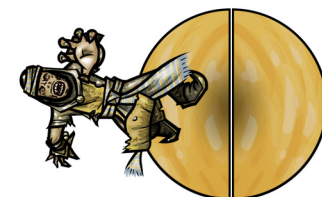
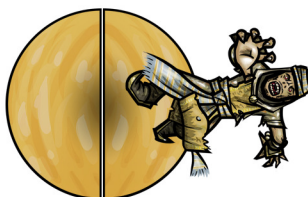
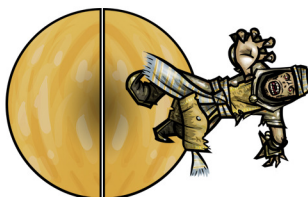
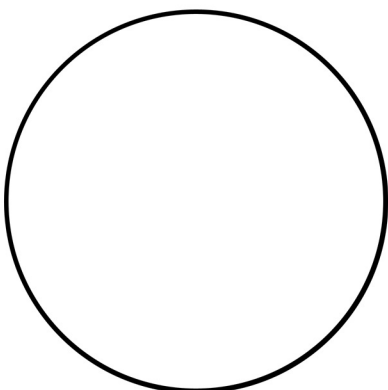
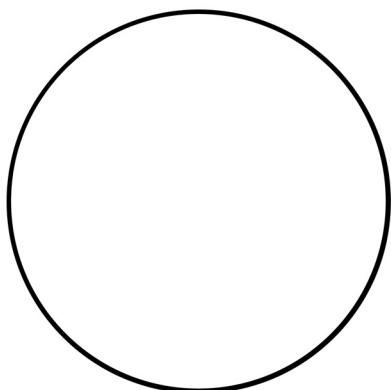
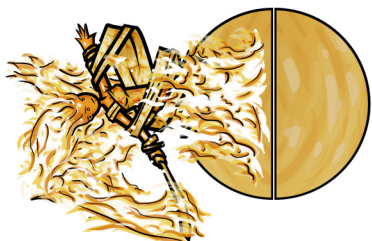
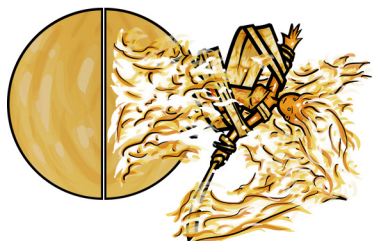
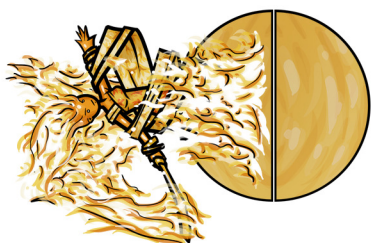
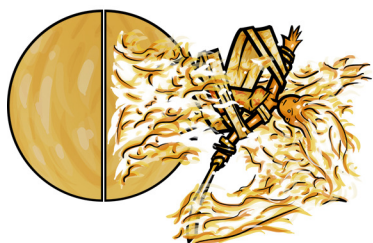
Score the head along the red line, fold, and glue onto the head tabs. Hold together until the glue sets, as above.

Once the glue has set, fold, bend, and curl the neck and tail into whatever position you desire.

Congratulations! You have a giant mamba to devour your players!

First, follow the instructions found in the free Pathfinder Paper Miniatures instruction PDF, which can be found on Paizo.com.

While gluing the main body portion and base, make sure not to glue the white tabs on the top and front of the body together; these tabs are used to hold the head, legs, and carapace. Once the body's glue has set, fold the tabs away from each other.

Glue the lower jaw's white base onto the tabs on the front of the body. Gently curl the lower jaw so that it is slightly above the miniature's base. Then, glue the head to the tab. Fold the mandibles up until they are above the level of the mini's base. Hold together until glue sets, as per your glue's instructions.

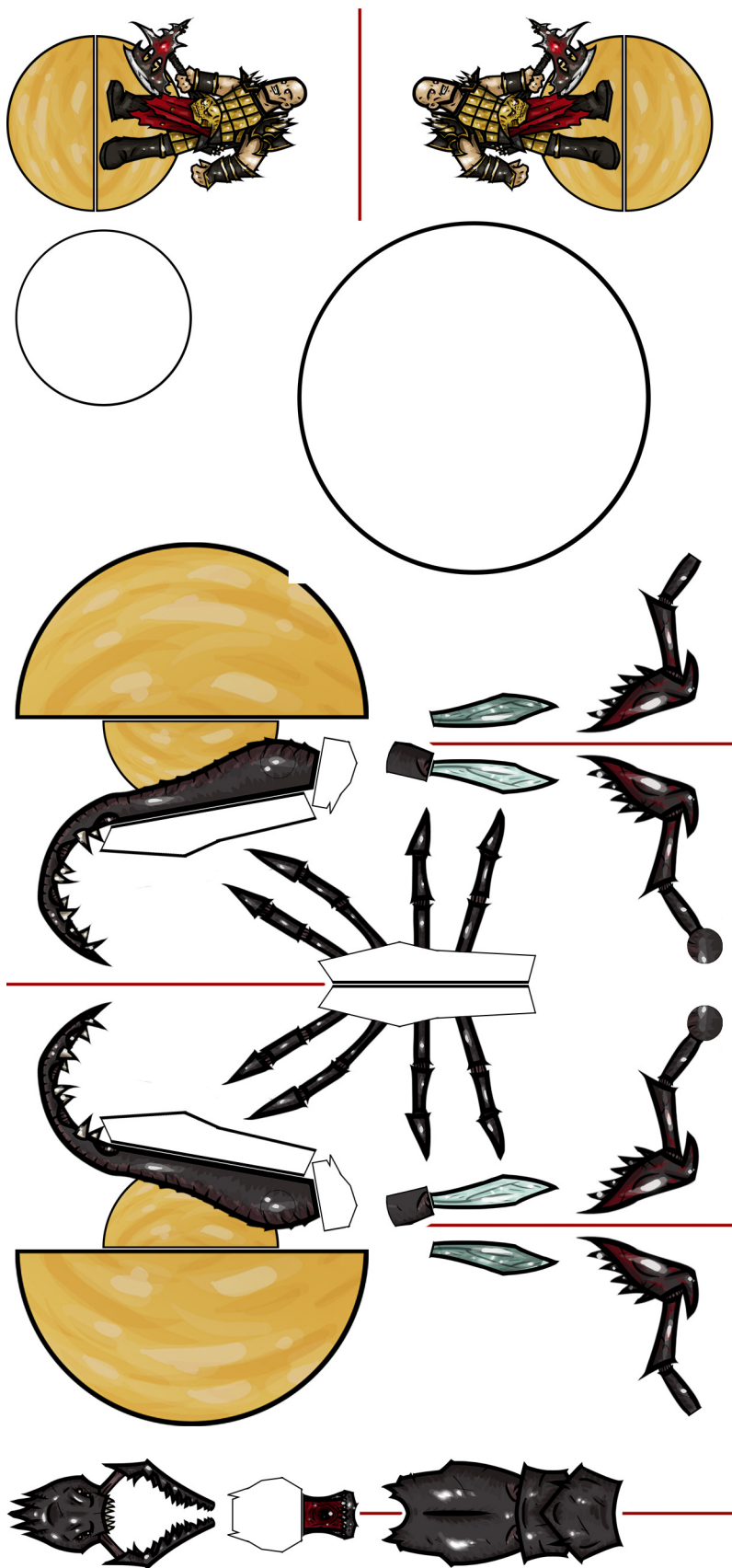
Score or cut the leg section along the white line that runs through the middle of the leg tabs. Glue the legs onto the top tab. Next, score the carapace along the red line, and glue on top of the leg tabs. Hold until set as before, then gently fold the carapace and leg parts down until they make about a 30-degree angle.

Attach the large front legs to the circles on the sides of the body. Make sure the arms will not collide with the carapace and legs; otherwise, the angle of their placement is up to you. Fold the arms out perpendicular to the body.

Fold the wing tabs colored-side towards the back of the wing (the lighter blue part). Then glue the tabs onto the carapace. Hold until set as before.

Once the glue has set, fold, bend, and curl the tail, wings and legs into whatever position you desire.

Congratulations! You have the mighty daemon Xulthos to devastate your players!
