

SINGAPORE NATIONAL OLYMPIC COUNCIL (SNOC) MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR AWARD PROGRAMME (MAP) 2009 to 2011

- 1. The MAP serves as an incentive scheme to reward medal winners in the Olympic, Asian, Commonwealth and SEA Games, and record breakers in the South East Asian and Asian Games.
- 2. The awards vary in amount in the respective Games represented. There is also a variation between awards for individual events medal winners, team event* medal winners and team sport** medal winners.
- 3. Awards are sponsored by the Tote Board and Singapore Pools (Pte) Ltd.
- 4. Awards are given to the athletes and not to the respective National Sport Associations. Awards are taxable.
- 5. Athletes shall be rewarded up to a maximum of three individual gold medals won at SEA Games, up to two individual gold medals won at the Commonwealth Games and Asian Games, and the first gold medal won at the Olympics.
- 6. Athletes who break the South East Asian or Asian Games records will be awarded \$5,000 and \$50,000 respectively. This incentive does not apply to sports with no official records.
- 7. It is mandatory for all athletes to plough back 20% of the MAP awards to their National Sports Association for future training and development.
- 8. Categories of awards for the Olympic, Asian, Commonwealth and SEA Games are listed in Annex 1.

** Team sport: Basketball, Cricket, Dragon Boat, Netball, Football, Hockey, Rugby, Softball, Volleyball, and Waterpolo

Kindly note that the above lists are not exhaustive.

^{*} Team event: Athletics (relay team), Badminton (doubles, mixed doubles, team), Bowling (doubles, trios, and team of five), Swimming (relay team), Sepak Takraw (regu and team), Sailing (420, 470, Optimist team), Shooting (doubles and team), Squash (team), Silat (artistic team), Tennis (doubles and taem), Table Tennis (doubles, mixed doubles, team), Volleyball (beach), Gymnastics (Women's Artistic Group)
