A New Sporting Vision for Singapore

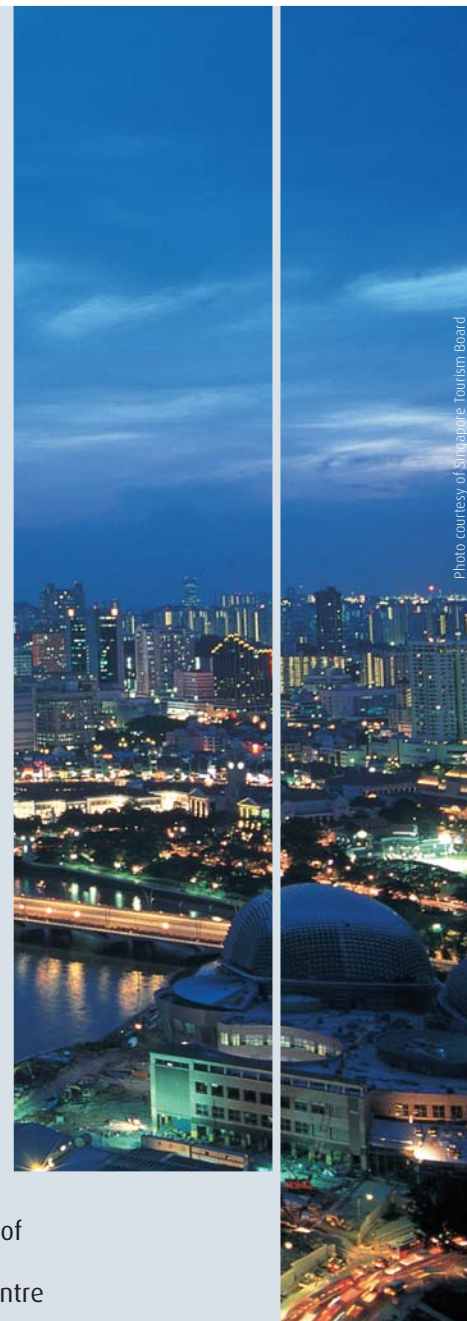

The Singapore Sports Council is leading the redevelopment of the current Singapore National Stadium and the surrounding area into a multi-purpose Sports Hub using a Public Private Partnership (PPP) procurement process.

It is proposed that the Sports Hub will incorporate:

- ~ New 55,000 capacity National Stadium including retractable roof
- ~ Existing Singapore Indoor Stadium designed by Kenzo Tange
- ~ New 3,000 capacity Multi-Purpose Indoor Arena cum Sports Centre
- ~ New Aquatic Centre
- ~ Supporting Leisure and Commercial development opportunities

The Sports Hub will form a major element of longer-term plans for a vibrant Sports City. The Sports Hub and the surrounding facilities will be the largest-ever sports and leisure development in Singapore and will be a major focus for sporting and lifestyle activities in Singapore in the future.
