

Sea Turtle

Check out how we conserve the beautiful but endangered marine turtles through our Sea Turtle Breeding Program and Turtle Rescue and Rehabilitation efforts.

Sea Turtle Breeding

We have been working closely with Nanyang Technological University in Singapore and the Port of Nagoya Aquarium in Japan. Many of the turtles on display at Underwater World Singapore have been captive bred, and together with Port of Nagoya Aquarium, we were involved in the first ever captive breeding at an aquarium, of the highly endangered Hawksbill Turtle.

Turtle Rescue and Rehabilitation

The Agri-food & Veterinary Authority of Singapore (AVA) has sent injured turtles to Underwater World Singapore for rehabilitation. Some of these turtles were in horrific condition after being rescued from smugglers by the Singapore Marine Police. For over a decade, we have treated and cared for these injured turtles, with many healthy turtles being released back into the wild, including 13 Green Turtles and 2 Hawksbill Turtles at the beach in Sentosa in September 1998. Hopefully these turtles may breed and add to the turtle population around Singapore.
