Land Crabs

If you think all crabs are marine, think twice! Learn about the various species land crabs like the rainbow and vinegar crabs in our Land Crabs Zone. The biggest land anthropod, the Coconut Crab, is also found here. Be sure to also watch the Land Hermit Crabs scuttling by in our specially designed floor tank!

Do you know...

- Crabs can be subdivided into false (Anomuran) and true (Brachyran) crabs.
- The Land Hermit crab and Coconut crab are not true crabs but hermit crabs, which are false crabs. Hermit crabs have their fourth and fifth pairs of legs tucked under the body and hide their soft abdomen in the shells that they carry.

Marine Crabs

At our Marine Crabs Zone, you will have an opportunity to see the largest ocean crab in the world, the Giant Japanese Spider Crab. Of course, do not miss the smaller but no less interesting crab species like the shy-looking box crab, frog-like Spanner crab, the vain decorator crab and more!

Do you know...

- The decorator crab is also called the Velcro Crab. It uses bits of sponges, seaweed, shells and debris to stick onto the fine hooked hairs of its body and legs. These 'decorations' camouflage the crab and the distasteful nature of some sponges also deters predators. (please confirm if this sticking of smelly sponges to their shells is for the sponge or decorator crabs?)
- The Giant Japanese Spider Crab is known to grow up to 3.7m from the tip of one outstretched claw to another! It can weigh up to 20 kg.
