Call For Entries

Open to students of local, International and selected overseas schools. Each team to consist of 2-3 members.

Primary Category : Pri 5-6 students Secondary Category: Sec 1-5 students

Tertiary Category : Junior College, Polytechnic and University students

Project Requirements

Step 1

Read about and learn as much as possible about coral reefs, their importance in the marine world and the threats that they are facing.

Step 2

Set up your very own blog with the objective to inspire more people to help protect the oceans, especially coral reefs. Your blog as at the date of submission must have at least:

- The blog title
- A minimum of 15 posts in Standard English. Suggested contents and topics:
- Demonstrate your team's passion about marine conservation
- Share videos or photo documentation of your conservation efforts, for example, beach cleanup or an exploration at the seashore etc.
- Highlight threats to the oceans
- Articulate the purpose of IYOR 2008
- Garner support for coral reef conservation Describe actions that the public can take to conserve the ocean
- Add on any other posts related to the IYOR 2008 theme
- Names and/or profiles of all team members, teacher-in-charge and school
- You may also add in quizzes, links to websites by conservation groups or any other features to make your blog more interesting!

Step 3

Once your blog is set up, email your blog url to uwspl@underwaterworld.com.sg by Sunday 7 September 2008 including details:

- Email subject header "YMBA 2008 (name of team and school)"
- Indicate category: Primary, Secondary or Tertiary
- Include names, email addresses and contact numbers of all team members and teacher in charge
- Name of team leader
- Name and mailing address of school

Judging will take place within the window period of 8 - 12 September 2008.
